2040 Water Resources Policy Plan workshops in October

Everyone is welcome to attend one of our upcoming workshops in October. Whether you're a community leader, decision-maker, city planner or engineer, watershed management organization, or have a general interest in the quality and quantity of water resources of the metropolitan region, all are welcome.

Community workshop topics

The workshops in October will cover the following topics:

- **Provide** information about the Council's "One Water" approach to water resources planning. This involves greater integration of our water supply, wastewater and surface water planning efforts.
- **Discuss** emerging issues in the water supply, wastewater and surface water areas.
- **Gather** your feedback on draft policies and strategies for the 2040 Water Resources Policy Plan, especially whether they are addressing the water supply, wastewater and surface water challenges and opportunities you are experiencing in your communities.

The input you provide now will be used to help inform revisions to the 2040 Water Resources Policy Plan before the draft is released for official public comment early next year.
